Solid Anchor Points

1. What God is like

- He's incomparable (v2)
 - He knows everything (v3)
 - He can do everything (V4-8)
- The world belongs to Him, He made it (v8)

We don't need to fear anything!



Solid Anchor Points

2. What God will do

- He will sort things out! (v5a, v8, v9)

HOW? WHEN?
