Simeon

A righteous and godly and *patient* man! Luke 2:25-35

How would we describe Simeon? • 1--he was led by the Spirit:

Are you being led by the Spirit? Can you sense his tug, push, or pull? Simon was controlled and led by the Spirit.

How would we describe Simeon?

 2--He was <u>patiently waiting</u> for the "consolation of Israel".

The Israelites waited 400 years for God's deliverance from Egypt. They waited again to return to the city from Babylon. They waited centuries for the promised Messiah. Patience = contented waiting How patient are you? Do you wait for God's answer, or do you go ahead like King Saul, with your own plan?

How would we describe Simeon?

- 3--he was a man <u>ready to face</u> <u>death</u>. "You may now dismiss your servant in peace (v. 29)."
- Mt. Henry: "See here, how comfortable the death of a good man; he departs in peace with <u>God</u>, peace with his own <u>conscience</u>, in peace with <u>death</u>."

How would we describe Simeon?

4. He was a man who knew the promises of God well. He gave us a compilation of OT Scriptures: Isaiah 52:10, "The Lord will demonstrate his holy power before the eyes of all nations. The ends of the earth will see the salvation of our God."

Is. 46:13; 42:6-7; Isaiah 40:5; 49:6. Foreshadowing of the Great Commission. Acts 4:12; Gal. 4:4-5; 1 Cor. 1:23; 1 Pet. 2:6, 7.

Keys to Simeon's patient waiting

1. He waited until the Spirit made things clear.

2. He was confident that the consolation of Israel was coming in his life. He had faith in God's promises.

3. He was ready to meet the Lord. Again he knew God's timing was best.

4. He was immersed in the Scriptures. The word of God always pointed him to God's ultimate plan for the universe. He was willing to wait for that to be fulfilled.

How's your patience (contented waiting)?

- Is your life quiet, assured, full of faith in the God who does not lie? You can be patient by faith!
- 1. Realize that you already have patience as a fruit of the Spirit
- 2. Express your faith to God that he is able to empower you to be patient.
- 3. Watch God bless you with a patient spirit!
