 Small group of weak people amongst powerful nations


 Encourage Israel in their mission to live out and praise God among the nations




Earth compared...

- Who he is
 - Judge (12, 14)
 - Protector (21-22, 35)

- The creation rejoices (30-33)

What do we learn?

 Thanksgiving is a missionary act – carried out before the nations
