BACKED BY EVIDENCE

- Miracles he performed
 - -Great, exceeding human power
 - -Many more than OT prophets
 - Remarkable in variety
- In front of his own people

MIRACALS

- Beneficial
- Unostentatious
- Impersonation could be detected
- Conform with predictions about the messiah

Jews expectant and looking for the messiah did not believe

- Their disbelief fulfilled prophecy
- They had blind eyes and hardened hearts
- Blindness at first voluntary then a punishment of God

A minority who did believe chose to suppress their convictions for understandable but ultimately selfish motives

THREE RESPONSES
