- John comments on purpose of Gospel - vss. 30-31

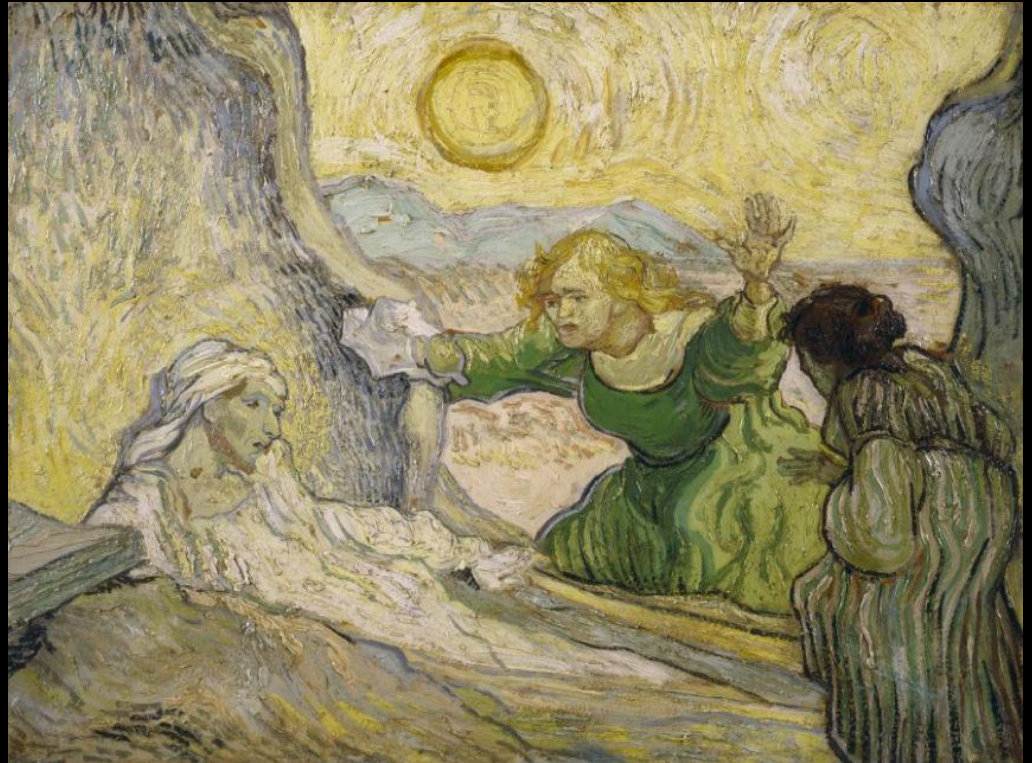
What does the Resurrection Mean? Life

have been sent

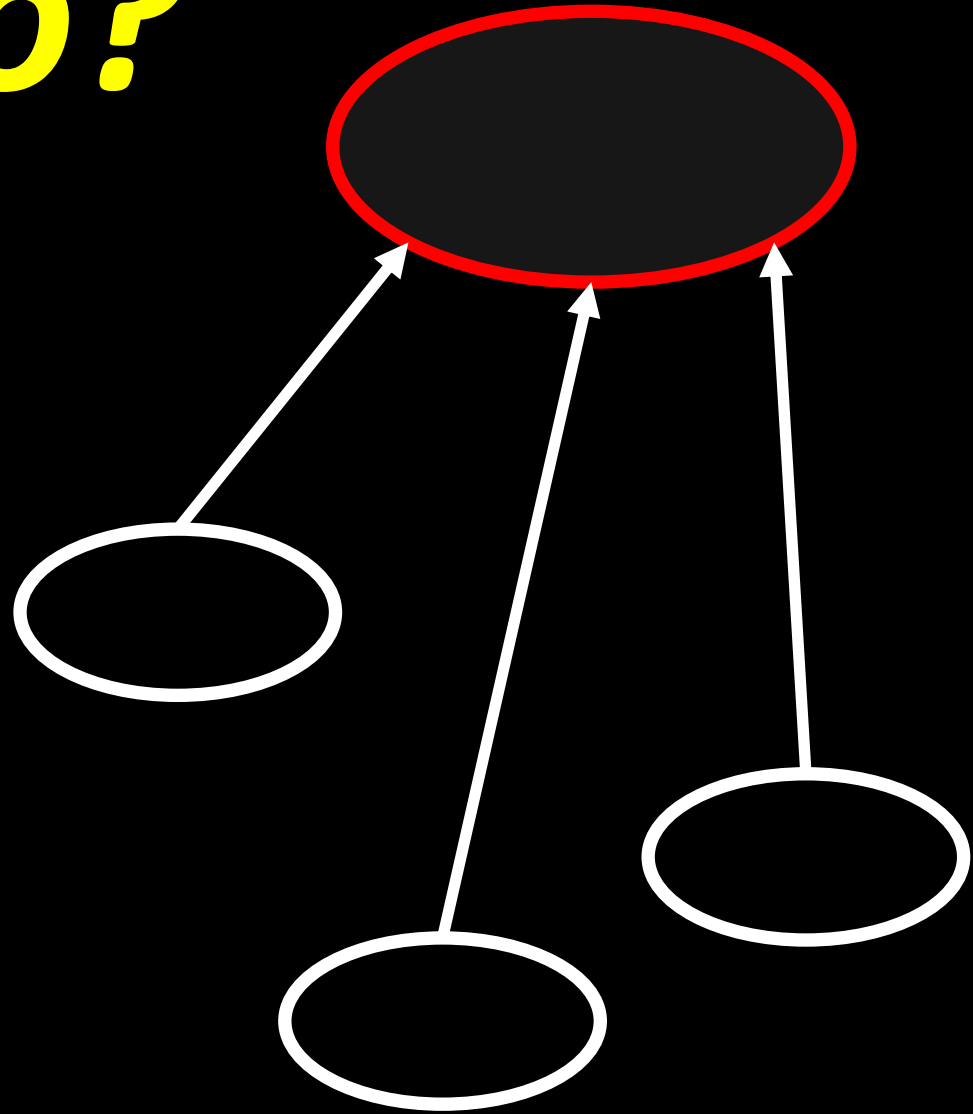


So?
