glorious inheritance

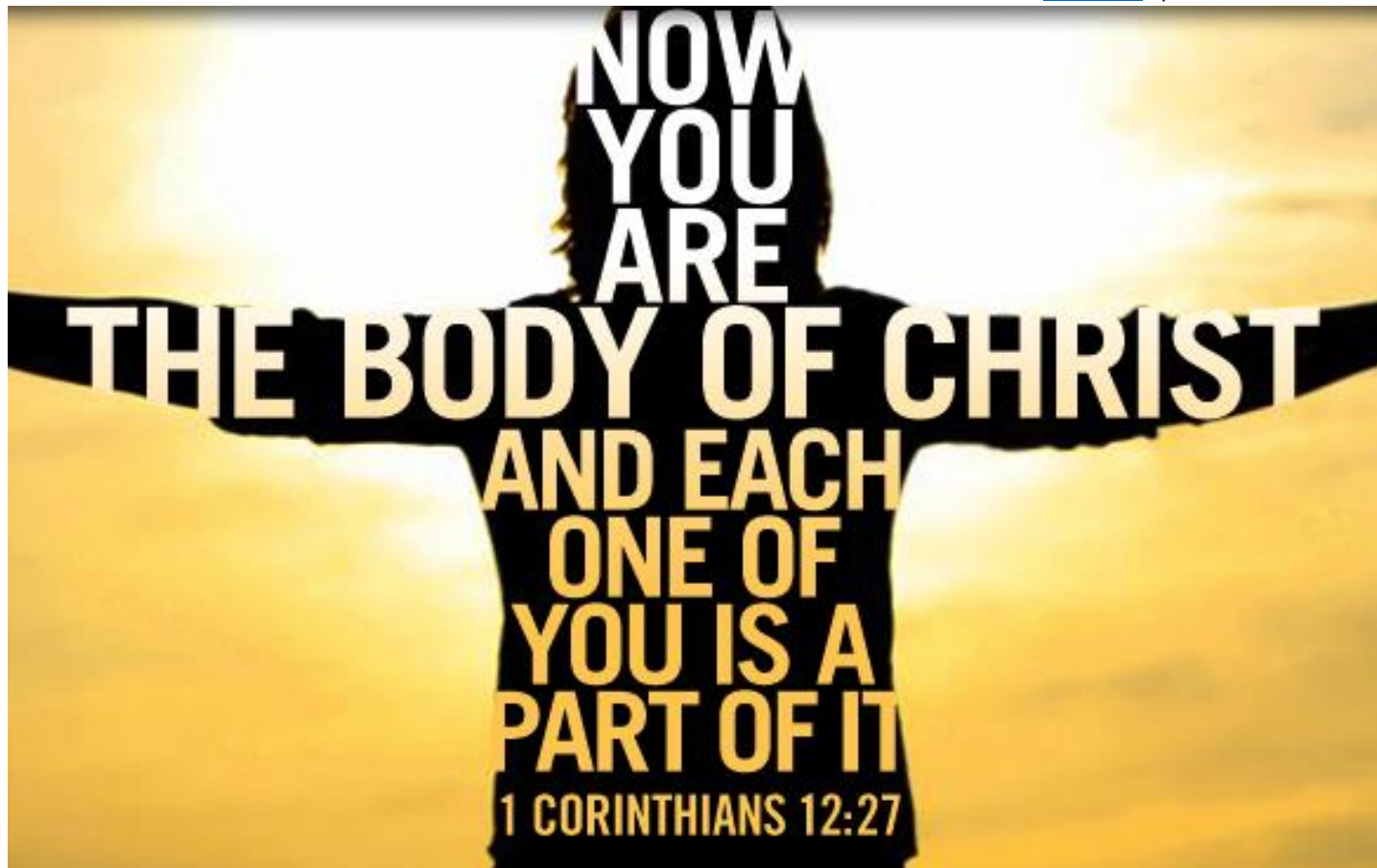
Joining that “great
