Inward Change

- The intimate sign of covenant – circumcision
- Circumcision of the heart
- Christ, our circumcision(Mark 15: 34, Isaiah 53:8)

'So what if you are baptised? So what if you are a church member? This only counts for anything if there has been a real change in your life, if you heart has been truly affected. Don't you know that you are not a Christian if you are only one externally, that real Christianity is not about having confidence in external things?

No, a Christian is someone who is a Christian inside; what matters is inner baptism, a heart-membership of God's people. And this is a supernatural work, not a human one.
