


The last 7 days have been absolutely fantastic – we have so much to thank God for......




It was wonderful to celebrate 2 baptisms on Sunday! It was so good to hear the testimonies of how God has been at work in people's lives.

Update on the Easter Thank Offering

This year our Thank Offering will be split between 'The Haven' (a Hertfordshire based, Christian organisation working with young people) and the 'Strengthening Families Project'.

We are delighted to let you know that so far, the church family have given **just over £7000** towards these two great projects! We know that both charities will be thrilled to receive this amount of money to help fund their work. Thank you so much for your generosity.

Below is a little reminder of where your Thank Offering will be going:



The Haven provides support for young people aged 11-18, with the aim of reducing the life-limiting effects of problematic anxiety. Through support groups, run in partnership with local churches, and through groups run in secondary schools, Haven provides life-changing tools and techniques to increase participants' mental resilience.



The 'Strengthening Families Project' is an 18-month programme which helps families to acquire the skills needed to develop micro-business plans, see improvements in their general and mental health, and grow in ways of expressing love between family members. Since the project began, families have also been able to access government support for low-income families and disability benefit.
